

Practical Information

Venue

The meeting will be held at the Belgian Science Policy Office (BELSPO).
Address: Avenue Louise, 231 - Brussels, Belgium.



Access

The building is located in the 'Bailli/ Baljuwwijk' district. This neighbourhood is easily accessible by public transport. The building is located at equal distance from stop 'Vleurgat' and stop 'Bailli/Baljuw' (3 minutes walk).

From train stations

-From Brussels Midi/ South Station

Take the tram 81 or 83 and stop at 'Bailli'.

Alternatively, take the metro: lines 2 and 6, and step down at 'Louise/ Louiza', then take the tram 94 to 'Bailli'. By taxi, ca. 10 min journey, depending on traffic (around 15 Euros).

-From Brussels Central Station

Take the bus 38, direction 'Héros/Helden', and step down at 'Vleurgat' stop.

-From Brussels Nord/ North Station

Take the metro at 'Rogier' stop, step down at 'Louise/ Louiza'. From Louise stop, take the tram 93 or 94 and step down at 'Bailli'.

From SN Brussels Airport

Take the train to Brussels Midi/ South station (a train leaves every 20 minutes and it is a 20 minutes journey). Then, take the metro 2 and step down at 'Louise/ Louiza'.

Take the bus 12 direction Brussels City and step down at 'Schuman' (30 minutes journey). At Schuman stop, take the metro line 2-6 or take the bus 60.

By taxi, ca. 45 minutes journey depending on traffic (around 50 Euros).
