The conference will bring together representatives of national and international scientific institutes to explore and discuss the opportunities and strengths related to **Biodiversity Informatics and Open Data**. Three keynote speakers will start the day :

During the breaks, there will be, in addition to coffee and sweets, a <u>poster</u> <u>session</u> and a <u>fair</u> where you can find information and tools which can help you in your future research.

Biodiversity Informatics deals with the application of informatics techniques to biodiversity information for improved management, presentation, discovery, exploration and analysis of scientific data. Combined with open data sources on the Internet, this is a powerful new approach in doing research. We hope this conference will offer networking opportunities and foster debate among participants. Through your participation, you can help developing issues to be further explored by the project, and to be fed into a series of dedicated workshops that will be organised after the conference.
